Now, I'm in the process of doing the Capital Campaign "Generations of Faith," we have almost reached half of the goal while we are still in the silence phase.

All of those and many more had happened during those six years that went very fast and the term will come to an end at the end of this month. Now, it is the time for me to move on to some other shore, where God has called me. I am in the process of packing my bags and hopefully to be finished by the end of June. Then I will leave peacefully with the feeling of a job well done for this is a great parish with great parishioners. I will also go, with a sense of appreciation and gratitude for having the privilege of ministering among you and with you for the past six years. Fr. Dumont
