**Faith Formation Corner**—Formerly Called CCD Classes for the Year 2018 –2019 began Sun Sept 9, 2018. . Regular classes are every Sunday beginning with the 8:30 AM Mass after which children will proceed to the Father Sinonetti Center.

**Remember:** Any child who received Baptism and started the 1st grade in Public or Catholic Private school must start a 2 year First Communion preparation before receiving Holy Communion. Public school children only must register for On-going Formation classes until they begin their 2 year confirmation preparation. Catholic Private school children must register for their two year Confirmation preparation before receiving the sacrament.

Please be sure to speak to Sr Doryne at 718 -649-1006 She is here on Mondays & Thursdays in the Parish Center

Please be sure to register your Public School child/children every year after they have received their first Holy Communion until they make their Confirmation in the 8th grade. If this doesn't happen they may not be able to receive their Confirmation. It is very important they attend these on going classes each year.
